12 PEOPLE CONSIDER IT -- THEY DON'T DO IT BECAUSE THEY ARE TRYING  
13 TO BE DISRESPECTFUL.

14           THE PROBLEM IS, IS THAT ALL TOO OFTEN IT'S TAKEN FOR  
15 GRANTED. AND UNLESS JUDGES START TELLING YOU THAT YOU ARE  
16 DOING IT, YOU AREN'T GOING TO CHANGE YOUR HABIT. AND YOU NEED  
17 TO CHANGE THAT HABIT.

18           **MR. REDACT**: I UNDERSTAND, YOUR HONOR.

19           **THE COURT**: OKAY. SUBMITTED?

20           **MR. REDACT**: THANK YOU, YOUR HONOR.
